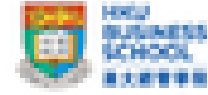
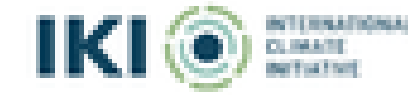

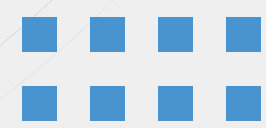

Forum Background



As Asia continues its rapid economic growth, the region faces the challenge of sustaining development while addressing the escalating impacts of climate change. Transition finance has become a crucial mechanism to guide the low carbon transition of the economy and the society. However, realizing its full potential requires collaborative efforts to enhance capacity across the whole ecosystem, including policy makers, regulators, financial institutions, and other stakeholders, to foster meaningful and sustainable transformation.

To support these efforts, the **Capacity-building Alliance of Sustainable Investment (CASI)**, co-hosting with the **Hong Kong Monetary Authority Infrastructure Financing Facilitation Office (HKMA-IFFO)**, the **HKU Jockey Club Enterprise Sustainability Global Research Institute (HKUJC ESGRI)**, and the **CFA Institute**, will convene a one-day forum during **Hong Kong's Green Week**. This forum provides an important platform for advancing capacity-building on sustainable and transition finance across Asia. It will feature keynote speeches, panel discussions, and interactive sessions on topics such as transition planning, disclosure, and financial product innovation.

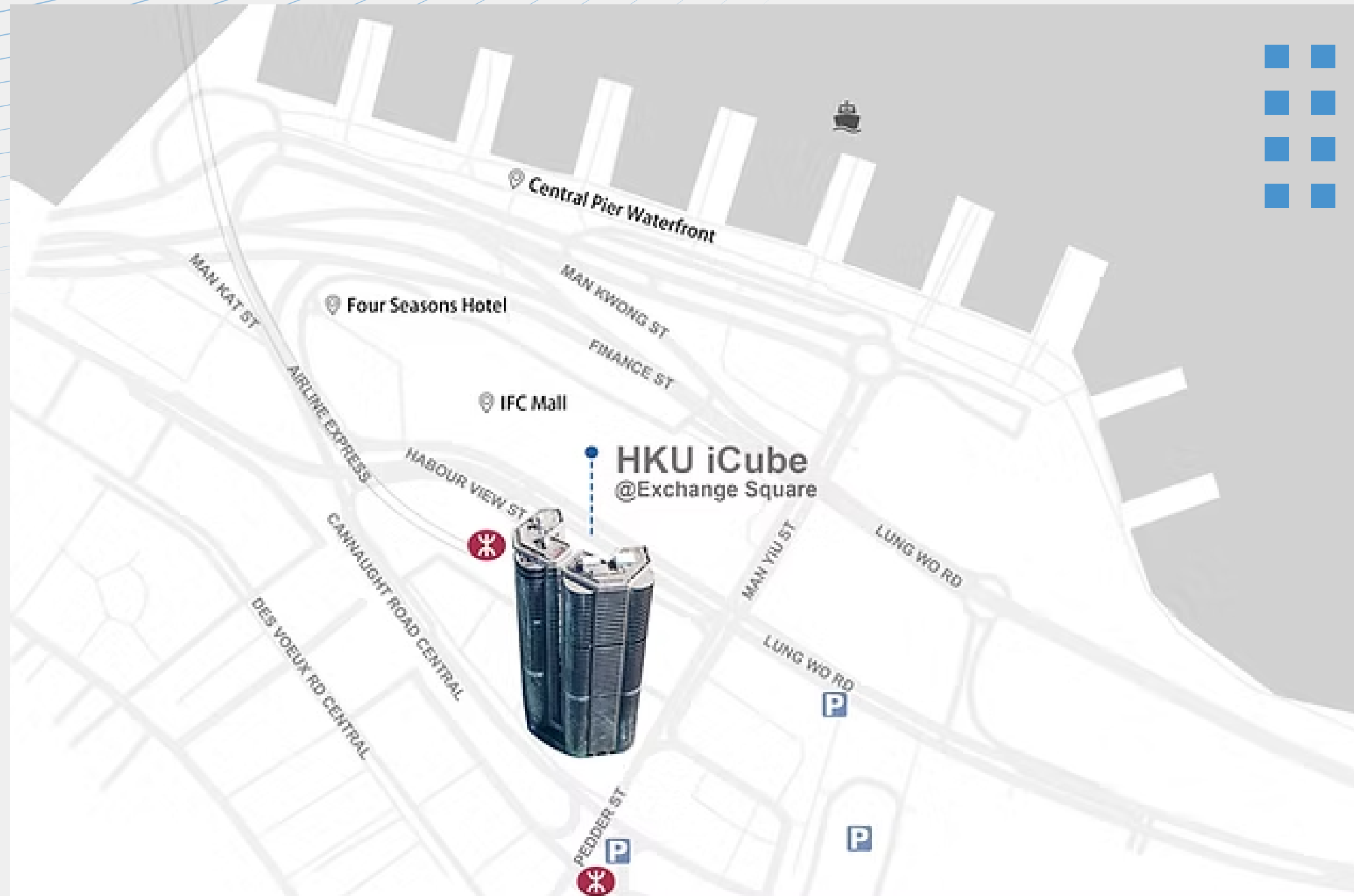

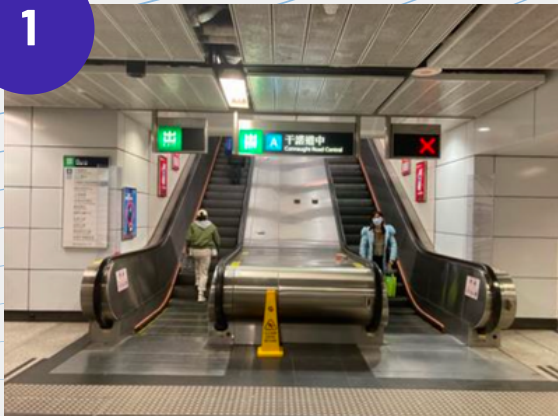

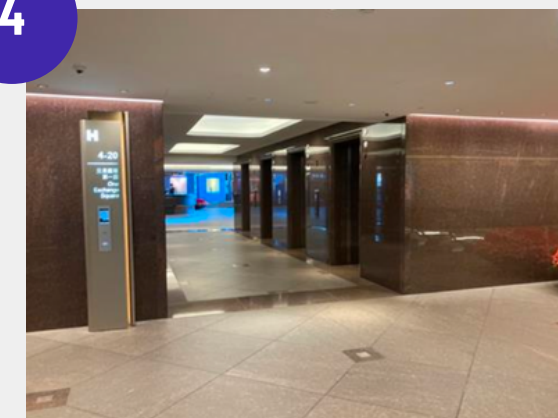
Go to the footbridge and cross

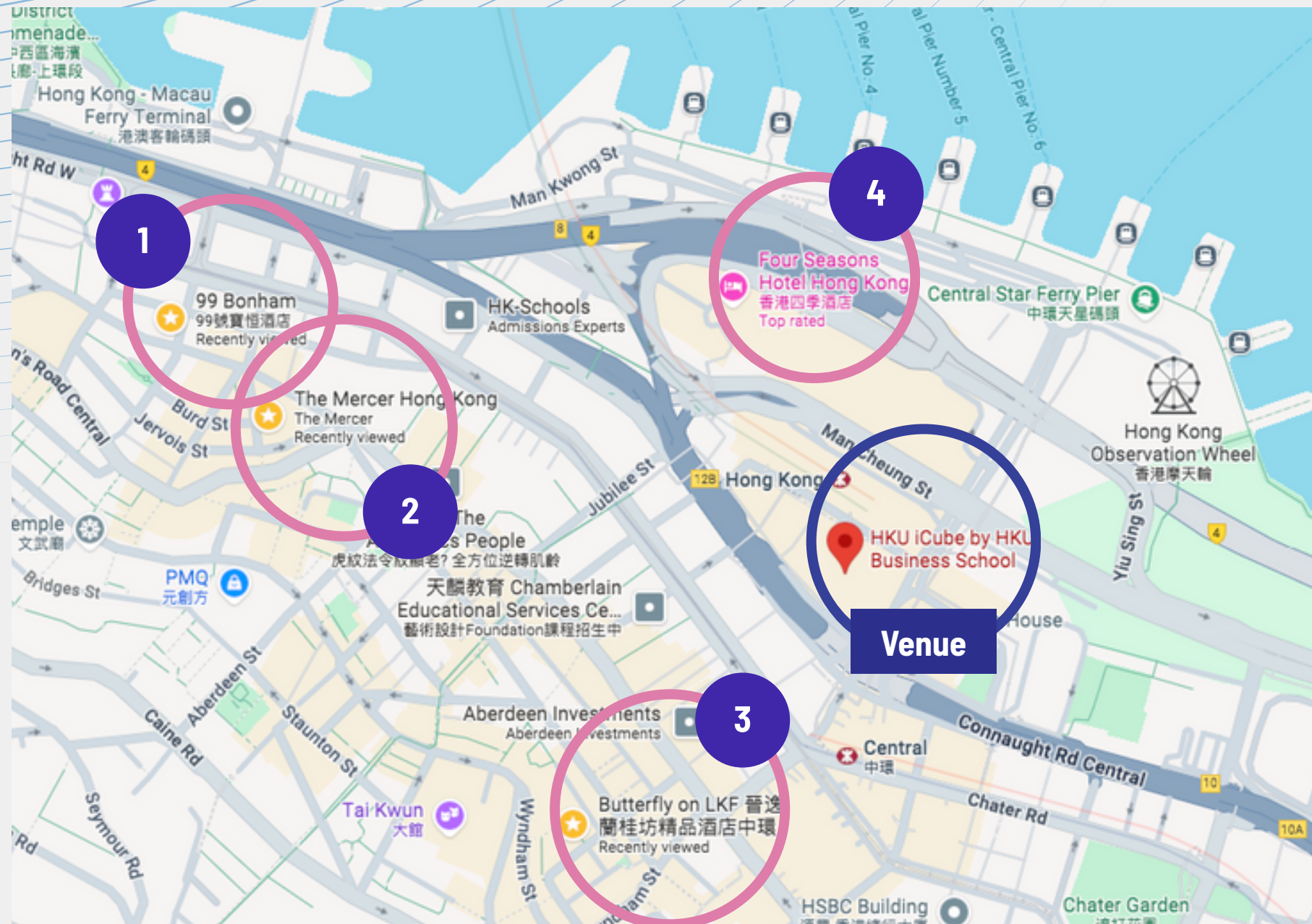


Find the "H" hallway of Two Exchange Square.

Transportation in HK

Hong Kong has a safe, efficient, and well-connected public transportation system. The most common and convenient options include:

- **MTR:** The MTR is the fastest way to travel around Hong Kong, covering major districts and routes. **Octopus cards** or contactless payment (Visa/Mastercard/Apple Pay) are accepted at select stations.
- **Buses and Minibuses:** An extensive network covers nearly every part of the city. Buses display English and Chinese route information.
- **Octopus Card:** A rechargeable contactless smart card that can be used on most public transport, convenience stores, and restaurants. Available at MTR stations and the airport.



Transportation in HK

- **Airport Express:** A fast and comfortable train service that connects Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) with the city centre (Central Station) in approximately 24 minutes.
- **Taxis:** Taxis are widely available and reasonably priced. They are colour-coded based on service areas:
 - **Red** taxis operate in most urban areas.
 - **Green** taxis serve the New Territories.
 - **Blue** taxis are limited to Lantau Island.

All taxis accept cash (HKD), and many also accept Octopus cards or credit cards.

Time Zone:

Hong Kong Standard Time (HKT), GMT+8.

Electricity:

Hong Kong uses a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz frequency. The standard plug type is **Type G**, which has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern.



Mobile Phone / Connectivity:

If you do not wish to activate international roaming, you can purchase a local Hong Kong SIM card at the airport or convenience stores. Major telecom providers include CSL, SmarTone, and 3HK. The international dial code for Hong Kong is **+852**.

General Information

Currency:

The local currency is the **Hong Kong Dollar (HKD)**, symbolized as “HK\$”. Most restaurants, shops, and hotels accept major international credit cards. However, **it is recommended to keep some cash for use at small vendors, local markets, and taxis.**

Exchange Rate:

1 USD $\approx$ 7.8 HKD (Approx.)

Tipping:

Tipping is **not mandatory** in Hong Kong but is appreciated.

- Restaurants: A 10% service charge is often included in the bill. If not, a 5–10% tip is customary.
- Hotel Staff: Around HK\$10–20 for porters or housekeeping.
- Taxis: Usually round up to the nearest dollar or leave small change.
